

## DeWitt COUNTY VISITOR NOTICE & RULES

# WARNING

You are about to enter into a secured area. Inmate behavior and discipline is closely regulated and controlled. Certain acts of an inmate or visitor are prohibited. Key among these is the transfer of contraband. Do not give or take anything from an inmate, without the expressed prior approval of the staff.

If you have anything you intend or would like to give an inmate, notify the officer immediately. If you are in possession of any contraband please take it out of the facility immediately, then return for your visit. Do not let an inmate talk you into violating the law or rules. The consequences are very serious. For your purposes contraband includes:

1. Alcohol
2. Chemicals, either commercial, or homemade
3. Purses
4. Food or consumable items not supplied by the facility
5. Firearm or ammunition
6. Knife, pointed, or sharp edged item
7. Legal pagers belonging to another inmate
8. Matches or fire making material
9. Metal cans
10. Mind altering substances
11. Money or financial instrument
12. Prescription or non-prescription medicines or drugs
13. Projectile or missile
14. Property of another
15. Tobacco or tobacco products
16. Fire making material such as matches, lighter, or any flammable substance.
17. Cell Phones
18. Diaper Bags (visitors may bring in one diaper, small wipes, one bottle)

### **Categorization of Offenses:**

Breaches of policy may result in an inmate being disciplined, reclassified, being charged with criminal offenses, or a combination of all three. Visitors or employees aiding or allowing an inmate to violate this policy may be subject to criminal charges and permanent removal from the facility.

### **Visitation Dress Code:**

All visitors must wear the appropriate dress code. If you fail to wear the appropriate clothing you will not be allowed to visit. If you reveal yourself in an inappropriate manner the visit will be terminated. The following clothing items may not be worn during visitation. If you are wearing any of the below listed items, you will not be allowed to visit.

- a. shorts
- b. open-toed shoes or flip flops
- c. bedroom slippers
- d. mini-skirts or dresses more than 1 ½ inches above the knee
- e. sleeveless shirts

- f. swimsuits
- g. spandex
- h. tank tops/spaghetti straps
- i. see-through or low cut blouses
- j. clothing with holes in inappropriate places
- k. pants hanging below the waist
- l. undergarments showing
- m. shirts may not reveal midriffs
